

Information Sources

Many different factors can affect the acquisition of information: the speed of communications (travel between planets take time), political infighting, inter-agency red tape, lost or misplaced records, computer malfunctions, clerical errors and the attitudes of those requesting or providing the data. Another important factor is the degree of openness of information — governments and many large commercial organizations make access to their records restricted unless ordered to release them via a court subpoena.

Some people specialize in finding information about others, such as private investigators, information brokers and criminal hackers (also called netrunners or cyberjocks). Although information may be available there may be safeguards in place preventing it from falling into the wrong hands. This article is an attempt to identify the various sources of information. The primary skills involved are: interrogation, investigation and databasing. Interrogation is obtaining information from a person through interviewing or intimidation techniques. Investigation is the knowledge of where information is found and how to obtain it. Databasing is knowing where on a computer network specific data is stored.

Levels of Access

Level 1 — Public Access — Records that are available to the general public (telephone books, public library books and directories, county court clerks office, newspaper microfiche files).

Local telephone books (white pages); internet directory search engines; consumer credit bureaus; commercial marketing databases; licensed information brokers; registered computer internet trackers; criss-cross directories (reverse searches); public library (who's who reference books and interviews or articles in back issues of magazines); newspapers and news reference library (social, business and financial events); television stations (television interviews or video taped articles and public access news footage).

Level 2 — Confidential Access — Records that are available to licensed agencies or registered commercial users with a specific need to know, or paying an annual fee to obtain such access (i.e., private investigators, banks, insurance companies, mortgage companies, personnel departments, law firms, information brokers, news media organizations).

State departments of motor vehicles (driver licenses: i.e., private, commercial, taxi-chauffeur, motorcycle); state vehicle registration offices (license plates and vehicle inspection data); county records offices, also called vital statistics (birth and death certificates, marriage and divorce records, name changes, adoptions, business license, Do Business As; state departments of state (corporate charter filings, records of corporate officers, business tax information); county property tax office (property deeds and mortgage liens); county voter registration records; city, county or state civil and criminal court clerk offices; national or planetary civil and criminal court clerk offices; county probate court clerk offices; family court clerk offices; national or planetary bankruptcy court clerk offices; state or county professional licensing agencies (for attorneys, physicians, bankers, brokers, teachers, adoption agencies, morticians, accountants (CPAs), dentist, contractors, private investigators, bounty hunters, couriers, pharmacist, engineers, insurance agents, barbers, psychologist, pilots, shipmasters, plumbers); national, planetary or Imperial ministries of state or foreign affairs (passports or travel visas); national post office (change of address records); state unemployment office (unemployment benefits and records of former employers).

Level 3 — Restricted Access — Records available only to authorized law enforcement personnel and official government agencies that's needed in the performance of their official duties.

The release of such information would normally require a court subpoena. Bank records; telephone company line traces and call audits; insurance company policy records; business financial activity records; a search of another persons computer hard drive; a physical search of a private residence or office; life insurance policy records; credit card company statements and purchase audits; internet service providers website and e-mail activity audits. Governments sometimes have problems obtaining this type of information since legal privileges exists between client-attorney, patient-physician, parishioner-priest or patient-counselor.

Level 4 — Classified Access — Records available only to authorized government agencies on a need to know basis. It involves information that if released, would be detrimental to the safety of investigative personnel or to the integrity of a criminal investigation or covert intelligence operation. Only personnel with appropriate security clearances and a genuine need to know should have access to this level of information.

This includes classified military, intelligence or criminal investigative records or files that would compromise the security of operations in progress or identify informants and undercover operatives. This is next to impossible to obtain for a private citizen and obtaining it otherwise could get one convicted of serious felony crimes such as treason, espionage, or at the very least, theft of classified government documents. Police internal investigations, internal security records, open and active criminal investigations, police personnel records, records pertaining to current litigation and records naming victims, undercover agents or confidential informants would all fall under this category.

(As part of a Court-Ordered Psychiatric Evaluation)

- Family & Juvenile History — Dysfunctional Family Dynamics (Domestic Violence, Emotional Neglect, Degrading or Insulting Behavior, Threats of Violence, Physical or Sexual Abuse, Harassment, Torture, Alcoholism, Drug Abuse, Infidelity, Suicide, Abandonment or Rejection by Parent, Secret Keeping, Specific Mental Illness, Intolerance of Specific Race or Religion, Death of Sibling, Fire Starting, Domineering or Overly Controlling Parent, Sleepwalking, Bedwetting, Handicaps and Disabilities, Sexual Exhibitionism, Other Behavioral Predispositions)
- Offender Characteristics — Lack of Empathy With Other, No Conscience or Remorse, No Sense Moral or Ethical Code, Enjoyment in Causing Pain or Suffering to Others, History of Torture of Animals, Writing or Fantasizing of Violence, Preoccupation with Violence or Death (Use of Video Gaming, Violent Stories and Movies), Multiple Personalities, Sociopathic Tendencies, Intolerance of Others Views or Behaviors, Poor Impulse Control, Stalking, Voyeurism, Homosexualism, Cross Dressing, Escalating Levels of Violence, Bullying (either as Victim or Offender), Self Mutilation, Necromancy, Bestiality, Cannibalism, Bizarre Nightmares, Belief in Supernatural or Magic, Hatred or Rage Towards Specific Gender, Religion or Race, Lack of Life Direction, Low Self-Esteem or Self Hatred, Self Righteousness, Extreme Religious Views, Pedophilia, Blaming Others for Problems, Defiance of Authority, Chronic Unemployment, Social Isolation (Loner, No Friends or Family), Obsession with Specific Weapons or Means of Violence, Use of Pornography or Prostitutes, Obsession with Serial Killers, Sexual Manipulation or Control of Others, Escape Route Planning

- Personality Testing / Interviews — Social, Verbal, Knowledge & Analytical Skills, Hostility Index, Eye Contact & Body Language, Sophistication Index, Anger, Anxiety, Suicide (Ideations, Cuttings, History of Prior Attempts), Sexual Dysfunction (Impotency, Frigidity, Bizarre Sexual Fantasies, Pedophilia, Sadism, Bondage), Obsessive-Compulsive Behavior, Paranoia, Narcissism, Attention Deficit Disorder, Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, Phobias, Manic-Depressive Episodes, Delusional Thinking

Order of Events

(upon the commission of a crime)

Crime Scene Investigation (Includes collections of evidence, photography of the scene and victim, trash pull, reenactment if necessary)

Composite Drawing or Photographic Image Identification (Photo ID and Mug Book are shown to living victims or eye-witnesses for initial identification)

Canvassing of Neighborhood (for eye-witnesses or background witnesses)

Arrest is Made (Either arrest warrant is issued or a violation of law has occurred and police make an arrest on the spot)

Court-Ordered Surveillance — This could involve electronic and photographic surveillance of a suspect, location or vehicle. It could also entail authorized use of a “sneak ‘n peak” warrant.

Comprehensive Body Search is conducted immediately upon arrest (All clothing, footwear, gloves, tools, keys, backpack or carry bags and other personal belongings are examined for evidentiary value / The suspect's body is also examined for evidence of injury or for confirmation purposes / Items such as weapons, drugs, tools, documentation or jewelry are confiscated. This will generally include a cavity search)

Personal Property Collection (All suspect's personal items not used as evidence or contraband will be inventoried and stored in the Police Property Room)

Suspect's Physical Samples (DNA, blood, hair, semen, urine, skin, saliva, fingernail clippings, gun shot residue, blood alcohol levels)*

Fingerprints / Palm-Prints (Taken for comparison with fingerprints on file or recovered from crime scene or victim's belongings)

National Criminal Records Check

Crime Board (Used if numerous victims and suspects to establish time-distance studies, geographic zones, photos of crime scene and victims and unique characteristics related to the crime)

Police Line-Up (If live victim or eye-witnesses are available)

Video Recording of Police Interview or Interrogation Sessions (Insuring that proper police procedures are followed and should the suspect offer a confession or verbal evidence)

Search of Suspects Homes, Businesses, Boats, Vehicles, Storage Areas or Developed or Undeveloped Property for Evidence (Requires a court-ordered Search Warrant)

Polygraph Test (Lie Detection Device operated by Certified Polygraph Examiner) (Voluntary in most cases and is not generally recognized by courts as evidence for or against truth)

EEG or Brain Fingerprinting (BFP) (operated by Certified BFP Examiner) (Voluntary in most cases but is recognized by most courts as evidence either for or against truth)
Psychiatric Interview (with court-appointed forensic psychiatrist) / Psychological Testing as necessary (i.e., WAIS, MMPI, TAT)
Voice Print Analysis (If voice recordings are part of the case)
Dental Impression Analysis (X-rays) (If dental impressions are part of the case)
Handwriting Sample Analysis (If handwriting is part of the case)

* Court ordered subpoena is required to obtain samples

** Court ordered search warrant is required to conduct property searches

National Agency Check (NAC)

Any government agency may request a National Agency Check (NAC) on individuals. This requires a query of all other government organizations to provide unclassified information if they have it available. The agencies can include:
